

Position: **Drilling Engineer / Drilling Superintendent**

Place of work: Quebec office and Wellsite

Type of employment: Consultant, with option at mid-term to be permanent

Task description:

Under the supervision of the Operations Manager, you will have to coordinate, direct and review drilling operations, within defined drilling programs and budget, in order to fully meet the prognosis target, pursuing the best results in terms of safety, time and cost effectiveness.

Your main responsibilities will be to:

- Supervise the day to day operations by liaising with the Drilling Supervisors, providing them with technical advice, ensuring that requirements needed for the rig operations are timely and effectively satisfied.
- Review programs and procedures for drilling, workover and completion. Quality check, cost estimates, ensures that risks are identified and appropriate measures are in place.
- Coordinate the services provided by Contractors in accordance with the planned activities and the logistic aspect.
- Supervise contractor services and proactively emphasize service quality enhancement.
- Enquire on well problems in order to understand causes and evolution; provide advice and detailed contingency program on the most effective solutions and corrective actions, to be approved by Management.
- Acknowledge and verify the drilling, testing, completion or abandonment programs with the aim of ensuring that all the necessary resources (services, materials and equipment) are requested, procured and are available for the scope.
- Collect, verify and distribute well reports; cooperate with the Well Operations Engineering discipline for the preparation of the end of activity report.

Competencies sought:

- Degree in Engineering (Petroleum/Mechanical or other) with a minimum of 15 years of experience in onshore drilling & completions
- Experience in unconventional plays (horizontal underbalanced or managed pressure drilling)
- In-depth understanding of the onshore drilling environment
- Ability to handle (alone or in close liaison with other team members) all aspects of drilling and completion operations, as well as the logistics



- Membership with Ordre des Ingénieurs du Québec (OIQ) or APEGA, or the competencies required for membership
- Strong communication skills
- Flexibility and versatility to adapt to rapid changes in the working environment (technical or regulatory)
- Mastery of English and French (if possible)
